I am writing to invite you to our UCAS and Aim Higher Event on Thursday 2nd March. There will be UCAS and Higher Level Apprenticeship presentations repeated at different times throughout the evening, providing important information about the benefits of both career routes and the processes students will need to go through to plan effectively for life post-18. The event will be attended by various training providers offering apprenticeships at all levels, representatives from universities and employers.

Students will be able to register with the providers on an individual basis and ask for information and advice directly; hopefully students will be able to 'widen their horizons' by finding out about opportunities which hitherto were unknown to them. **The evening will be of value to all Year 12 students** including those thinking of applying to University or looking at alternatives to Higher Education.
