

## **Beginning of Term Arrangements for the Sixth Form**

### **YEAR 12 ARRANGEMENTS**

Year 12 students need to come in to school at 8-40 am on **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September** for an assembly followed by a tutor group period that will finish at 10-05 am

Tutors will arrange individual interviews with each of their tutees and this may require them to stay in school later on Wednesday or to return on Thursday or Friday for an interview.

**All year 12 students will be expected to have their photograph taken during lesson 2 or 3.**

#### **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> and Friday 8<sup>th</sup> September**

Students will have individual interviews with tutors as arranged and may use the study facilities to finalise induction tasks and to seek advice from their subject teachers if they are experiencing difficulties with the work.

#### **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> September**

Students will need to be in at 8-40 am for tutor-time that begins promptly at 8-45 am. Lessons will then begin period 1. Students will have received their timetables and will need to be in school for all lessons from this point.

### **YEAR 13 ARRANGEMENTS**

Students need to come in to school at 8-55 am on **Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> September** and go to the theatre for an assembly where they will receive their timetables.

At 9-30 am there will be a presentation in the theatre for all students on writing personal statements led by a university admissions tutor from Loughborough University, followed by a practical workshop between 10 and 11 am to support students in beginning to draft their statements.

Students will also be able to have informal discussions with ex-students who are currently at university about the application process and the university experience in general.

After break at 11-30 am there is a Higher Level Apprenticeship presentation in the theatre, followed by an apprenticeship workshop in the library.
