An important element of your son/daughters GCSE history studies is the historical environment question which features on Paper 2 of the GCSE examination. For students who will sit their GCSE History in Summer 2019 the historical site in question is Ham House in Richmond, London and it is highly recommended that all GCSE History students undertake this visit to enhance their understanding of the site and its development.

For this reason we are organising a trip to Ham House which will take place on **(date as advised in July) 2018**. Students will travel by coach to Richmond and will have a tour of the site to support their learning.

Students will depart from Vandyke Upper School on the above date at **9.00am** and will return in time for the usual end of the school day at **3.05pm**. **Please be aware that if traffic causes a delay then students might miss the bus home and other arrangements will have to be made for them to travel home.** Students do not need to wear school uniform on this date however it is important that they are appropriately attired for visiting a historical site. Sensible footwear is recommended! The cost of the trip does not include lunch so students will need to bring either a packed lunch or money to purchase food from the café on site.

The cost of this trip is **£16.00**.
