Re: Skirts

I am writing to you again regarding school uniform to inform you of changes we are making to the style of skirt which is acceptable as part of the school uniform. Although many of the girls who choose to wear a skirt to school, are wearing ones that are appropriate, there remains a number of girls who continue to wear skirts that are far too tight and short for the school environment. Therefore, starting from **Tuesday 8th May**, any girl wishing to wear a skirt as part of her uniform, must wear an approved skirt.

The approved skirt is available from the **Wear2school** shop on North Street in Leighton Buzzard. It is the black pencil skirt from the **David Luke** or **Innovation** brand range and costs between £13.50 and £17.50 depending on size. The shop have a range of sizes currently in stock but can order any additional items within 48 hours.

Girls wearing any other brand of skirt will be asked to address the issue for the next school day and may be asked to borrow an item of uniform from school stock in the meantime.

Should any parent be unable to purchase a skirt through being in a position of financial hardship, there is a bursary scheme available. In this case please contact your child's Head of Year for more details.
