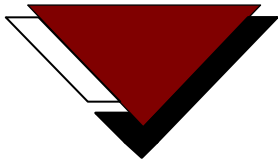

Student Bulletin and Extra-curricular / Revision Sessions

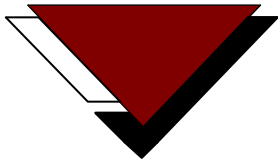
