

## GOVERNORS

Governors have a large amount of responsibility for the running of the academy and its long-term development. They control the expenditure of the academy and have to set a balanced budget. They appoint all staff (although this in practice is delegated to the Headteacher). They are also responsible for the maintenance of the academy site. They set the admissions policy and are involved in serious disciplinary matters. They have to provide, by law, certain returns to the Department for Education, which are used in the compilation of local and national statistics.

The full Governing Body meets once every half-term. Because of the complexity of a large academy, much of the detailed work is carried out in smaller committees.
